Tech VP's Report Gary Bovee

Well another fine GMC Western States Rally has come and gone. If you missed out on the Pueblo Experience, you missed out

on some GOOD tech seminars, especially seeing Manny Trovao disassemble and rebuild a GMC's THM425 transmission.

This is where, as your Western States Tech VP, I want to especially thank those GMCers who rushed to my aid when asked to fill in a few unexpected vacant seminar spots. They were Paul Array, George Beckman, Gene Fisher, Ken Henderson, Kerry Pinkerton and Randy Van Winkle.

Friday's first tech sessions started off with a "How To Keep Your Onan Running" by Gary Bovee. At every rally there are always folks asking what to do to get or keep their Onan's running. One thing that can be very helpful is to download copies of Duane Simmons "GMC Onan Power Drawer Electrical Trouble Shooting Demo" and "Onan Control Board Operation" to keep in your coach for when needed. Links to both documents along with other good Onan information is available at www. gmcidiotsguide.com, Chapter 5 – Trouble Shooting the Onan.

George Beckman stepped up to the plate on short notice and put together a slideshow – "Onan On Propane". He showed how simple it is to convert your Onan to propane. This session was especially good for those folks who have or are thinking about switching over to diesel power. No matter what, running the Onan on propane should increase the life span of these old engines. If you have ever seen the inside of an engine that has been powered by propane it looks so clean you could eat off of it!

Frank Condos did his scheduled seminar on "What Would You Have Done". Frank showed many slides of "before and after" pictures of his 1973 GMC that he is restoring. There was good interaction with the audience on how folks approached repairing their GMCs.

Kerry Pinkerton gave two back to back slideshow presentations one on "Rebuilding Your Cockpit Windows" and the other "Repairing the Shower Diverter". He again provided good handouts for both seminars as well as passing around a disassembled shower diverter so everyone could see exactly what he was talking about.

New GMC Western States member Paul Array gave a slideshow presentation on "Emergency Brake for Manny Brakes". His detailed slideshow presentation was very informative and allowed him to explain exactly how his emergency brake system works.

Kerry Pinkerton held another seminar Friday afternoon entitled "Line Voltage Thermostat for Your Heat Strip". He explained how this would be the best \$20 you will ever spend. His handout explained how those of us with coaches who have an A/C heat strip with only an on/off switch can install a line voltage thermostat. This will allow the heat strip to be thermostatically controlled rather than using an on/off switch.

Ken Henderson gave a seminar titled "What Do You Want to Know". He showed a long list of indexed email topics on the screen from the GMCnet. The audience could then choose whatever topic and ask questions. It was a good interactive session!

On Saturday Randy Van Winkle presented "Winker's Water Pump Control". He explained how he had installed the system in his coach and how handy it is to have multiple water pump switch locations to be able to turn the pump on or off. He says his wife is much happier now!

Gene Fisher followed with "Onan Maintenance 'PM' (Preventive Maintenance)". One of the important maintenance items he stressed was how the Onan's K1 relay needs to be rewired on all original solenoids so that they will not fail.

Gene Fisher and Billy Massey on short notice gave a seminar on "GMC & the Internet".

There are multiple ways to get GMC info – GMCnet, GMC Motorhome Photo Archive, FaceBook – Classic GMC Motorhomes, GMC Motorhome MarketPlace and the list goes on and on.

On Saturday afternoon Manny held his first seminar (tranny disassembly). He had not slept in 48 hours prior to his seminar. So a BIG thanks to Manny for having the fortitude to stick in there and make it to the Rally without rest and still keep his seminar commitments.

This seminar was the highlight everyone one of us gearheads was waiting to see. It was a very interaction seminar with Manny answering the audiences many transmission questions. Then on Sunday we got to watch him rebuild the tranny and again had a great interactive session.

That night after dinner there was a drawing and Manny's rebuilt transmission was given away to new Western State members George and Nancy Michalko. Hats off to Manny for his great transmission seminars and donating the tranny!
